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## **2011 CHEM SHOW Announces Revised Dates** *Convention Center Renovations Result In Earlier Event On November 1-3, 2011*

**WESTPORT, Connecticut...August 16, 2010** – Rescheduled renovations to the Jacob K. Javits Convention Center in New York City have made it necessary to move the dates of the next CHEM SHOW from December 6-8 to November 1-3, 2011. Construction that was originally planned for late December 2011 was moved up to begin just after Thanksgiving.

According to International Exposition Company (IEC), producers and organizers of the CHEM SHOW, the move to earlier dates in 2011 is being met with a positive response from exhibitors. The only way to maintain the original dates would be to move the Show out of New York, but a survey of previous visitors showed a very clear majority favor keeping the 2011 CHEM SHOW in New York City.

Widely recognized as the leading chemical processing event in North America, the 2011 event marks the 54<sup>th</sup> edition of the biennial CHEM SHOW and its 96<sup>th</sup> year of serving the chemical process industries. The CHEM SHOW has traditionally been held in November in New York City, and the last Show took place in 2009, attracting more than 7,000 industry professionals.

Following on the success of the 2009 event, next year's Exposition and Educational Conference will feature a targeted focus on such core processing topics as:
